## The Old Testament Lesson: *Genesis 6:7-13,18*

<sup>7</sup>So the LORD said, "I will wipe from the face of the earth the human race I have created—and with them the animals, the birds and the creatures that move along the ground—for I regret that I have made them." <sup>8</sup>But Noah found favor in the eyes of the LORD.<sup>9</sup>This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, blameless among the people of his time, and he walked faithfully with God. <sup>10</sup>Noah had three sons: Shem, Ham and Japheth. <sup>11</sup>Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight and was full of violence. <sup>12</sup>God saw how corrupt the earth had become, for all the people on earth had corrupted their ways. <sup>13</sup>So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them" <sup>18</sup>But I will establish my covenant with you, and you will enter the ark—you and your sons and your wife and your sons' wives with you."

## The Psalm: *Psalms 25:1-10* (Please read responsively)

<sup>1</sup>In you, LORD my God, I put my trust.

<sup>2</sup>*I trust in you; do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.*

<sup>3</sup>No one who hopes in you will ever be put to shame, but shame will come on those who are treacherous without cause.

<sup>4</sup>*Show me your ways, LORD, teach me your paths.*

<sup>5</sup>Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior, and my hope is in you all day long.

<sup>6</sup>*Remember, LORD, your great mercy and love, for they are from of old.*

<sup>7</sup>Do not remember the sins of my youth and my rebellious ways; according to your love remember me, for you, LORD, are good.

<sup>8</sup>*Good and upright is the LORD; therefore, he instructs sinners in his ways.*

<sup>9</sup>He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them his way.

<sup>10</sup>*All the ways of the LORD are loving and faithful toward those who keep the demands of his covenant.*

**The New Testament Lesson: *Luke 17:26-30***

<sup>26</sup>“Just as it was in the days of Noah, so also will it be in the days of the Son of Man. <sup>27</sup>People were eating, drinking, marrying and being given in marriage up to the day Noah entered the ark. Then the flood came and destroyed them all. <sup>28</sup>“It was the same in the days of Lot. People were eating and drinking, buying and selling, planting and building. <sup>29</sup>But the day Lot left Sodom, fire and sulfur rained down from heaven and destroyed them all.
